AUDITION REQUIREMENTS

- Prepared monologues are not required. Potential cast members will read scenes from the script.
- Please bring your calendar and be prepared to list all your time conflicts.

IMPORTANT DATES

- *Cinderella – a British Panto* opens 26 January 2023 and closes 12 February 2023. The ten performances are Fridays and Saturdays at 7:30 PM and Sundays at 3:00 PM.
- Rehearsals will start with the second read-thru on Tuesday, 22 November 2022 and will take place every weekday evening from 18:30h to 21:00h depending upon the cast members' schedules. Some weekend rehearsals may take place if necessary.
- Not all cast and crew members will be needed for every rehearsal, except the full week leading up to final tech and dress rehearsals. Everyone should, however, be available for the entire rehearsal timeframe, in case of changes and adjustments.

ABOUT THE PLAY

Cinderella – a British Panto is a wonderfully funny theater experience written by TLC Creative and will be directed by Keith D Greenleaf.

This British Panto is the classic rags to riches story!

Cinderella lives a life of drudgery, bullied by her horrible Ugly sisters, Salmonella and Listeria. Her muddled and confused father, Baron Hardup is powerless to intervene (he's more scared of them than she is!) and her only comfort is her pal Buttons! Prince Charming is holding a ball to meet his bride to be.

Can this be the chance that Cinders has been waiting for? Despite the best efforts of her two malicious Ugly Sisters, Cinderella shall go to the ball with the help of her Magical Fairy Godmother!

ROLE DETAILS

Some roles have already been cast and all roles receive a small expense allowance. "Acting Age" is more important than the actor's actual age. Cast of characters:

Cinderella - Female, Our heroine. Kind-hearted and long suffering – OPEN

Prince Charming - Female, (Principal 'boy') A dashing fellow. Heir to the throne will be played by Linda Kopp

Buttons - Male, the fun-loving link man character. Clever, quick witted and fast talking – OPEN

Listeria - Male, (Dame) Stepsister to Cinders and a thoroughly nasty piece of work will be played by Parag Naik

Salmonella - Male (Dame) The second Stepsister to Cinders and equally nasty – OPEN

Fairy Godmother - Female, A kind-hearted and all-powerful spirit will be played by Barbara Lawes-Breymann

Baron Hardup - Male, A rather confused, muddled character will be played by Stefan Lauster

Dandini - Female, Aide and confidante to Prince Charming will be played by Prachi Sakpal

Major Domo - Male, Palace official. A pompous and rather foolish fellow will be played by Martin Frank
